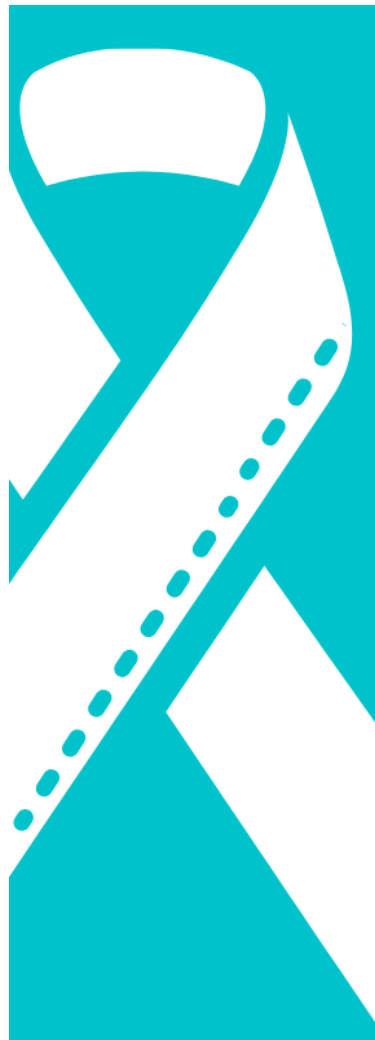


## WHAT IS SEXUAL ABUSE/ASSAULT?
